DYFFRYN NANTLLE ARCHERY CLUB

The Dyffryn Nantlle Archery Club has been offering sessions on Friday evenings at the Talysarn Community Centre. The sessions have been very popular, with up to 20 people having completed the first 6-week course. Twelve sessions have been held up to now with every evening being very busy. Many of Talysarn and Nantlle residents have put their names down for starter courses which begin in January and February 2008. There are 27 people on the waiting list since we started in Talysarn. If you are interested, the club will be in the Centre every Friday evening from 6.30-8.30pm. Why don't you come and have a chat? The course lasts for 6 weeks and will cost £1 a night. We were very busy at the Centre preparing for Christmas. On the 24th November 2007 a very successful Craft Fair was held with all kinds of stalls selling decorations, knitted items, food and Christmas cards etc.

On Monday 17th December many of the village residents came together to enjoy a 3-course Christmas lunch prepared by Lis and volunteers of the village. A big thanks for all their hard work, everybody really enjoyed themselves again this year. We look forward to seeing you in the New Year, hopefully with new and exciting activities being held at the Centre.

NANTLLE VALE ROYAL SILVER BAND

The Nantlle Vale Royal Silver Band recently competed in the annual North Wales Rally at the Rhyl Town Hall, and following on from the third place achieved last year, the band received a very favourable fourth place adjudication. The youth band achieved a commendable second place in their section for the second year running, so a big well done and congratulations to the youngsters! The senior band continues to compete against much larger bands from towns across North Wales, and would welcome new members who currently play brass instruments, or would wish to learn. Preparation will start in January for a range of spring and summer events such as Gŵyl Fai, Rail Ale, and of course rehearsing for the National Eisteddfod.

The local community in Talysarn will have noticed major renovations to the old Bandroom being carried out. The band has moved out so that builders can renew the roof, windows, flooring and toilet/kitchen facilities, as well as create a car parking area. Everyone is looking forward to moving back into the new-look building early in the New Year, but in the meantime we are grateful for being able to use the local chapel in Nantlle for rehearsals and meetings.

GRŴP BLODEUWEDD

Although the weather is now getting decidedly wintry, Grŵp Blodeuwedd are still very busy planning a number of spring projects. We hope to work with our young friends from Ysgol Talysarn once again to carry out a community tree planting exercise, the aim being to plant about 20 trees at various locations around Talysarn in late winter/early spring, subject to receiving final consent from Gwynedd Council. We also hope to work with the school to plant up to 10 new half-barrel planters around the Gloddfa Glai Bungalow site in early summer.

Once again we have lobbied Gwynedd Council this year to provide additional doggy bins around Talysarn and Nantlle, over the last couple of years we have managed to persuade the council to provide a few more litter bins and doggie bins around our community, as and when they have funds available.

Finally, we recently managed to persuade Gwynedd Council to allow us to recycle over 500 summer bedding plants that they had dug out of the flower bed at Plas Silyn, Penygroes. With care and the right facilities these plants will be over wintered and used around Talysarn and Nantlle next summer. As a result of our lobbying we have persuaded Gwynedd Council to change their policy to allow community groups to recycle plants that had previously been bound for disposal in a landfill site.
